I know that contact from school asking you to collect your child if they are showing symptoms is disruptive, but we are simply following guidance and really trying to protect our whole school community. I would be grateful if you would continue to distance, ensure that only one parent collects the child/ren and wear masks on the school drive. We need to once again work together to keep each other safe and our children in school. The rate in the area is high and many local schools have seen many of their bubbles popped this week. I know that as a school community, we can do this together!

I have been overwhelmed at the generosity of the school community in supporting the sponsored events in school and Miss Rickerby is keeping a running total which has far surpassed our expectations. There is still time to make your contributions and send your sponsorship money into school. Today – all the children have taken part in Race for Life and they have all done an amazing job. Some children even chose to try and run 5K which is 24 laps of the field! How fantastic are our children!

As the holidays are approaching, I know that families and children are starting to wonder about class arrangements and a letter about this will be sent out next week. Following this, we will also be then arranging some internal transition in a COVID secure way. As always we are looking at ways in which to make the transition to the next year group as smooth as possible for everyone.

I know that many of you will have enjoyed the England victory this week and I am sure that you will have plans to watch the game on Saturday with your families. Many of the children are very excited about the football and they have shown great enthusiasm for the sporting events that are on at the moment. Let us hope that England give us all something to smile about this weekend - although in my house I am only allowed to watch the football if it is recorded. According to my eldest child, I have always been a curse for the English team so I shall be taking myself off for some quiet time whilst the match is on - don't worry I will not risk watching it live! Please take care and keep safe during these strange times. Enjoy your weekend and keep smiling. We are hopefully nearing the end of this challenging period.
