CORONAVIRUS UPDATE – SCHOOL REMAINS OPEN AS PER DFE GUIDELINES

The Government announced last night that the UK is moving into the next phase of the Coronavirus action plan with the aim of delaying the spread of the virus. Should you have any concerns about your child's health you should follow the guidance provided by the NHS

PROCEDURES FOR DELAYING THE SPREAD OF THE VIRUS

From Monday 16th March 2020 until the Easter break, we will aim to reduce the number of visitors coming into school.

We will not hold whole School Assemblies during the 'delay' phase and enhanced phases of the virus for pupils or parents. This means that Celebration Assembly will not take place on a Friday. We will still celebrate weekly awards and badges but these will be presented in classrooms.

All children will be asked to wash their hands as they enter school, before break and before lunch.

Children have already started having lessons on handwashing and hygiene. We will ask all children who cough or sneeze to wash their hands immediately.

The school doors will continue to open at 8:45am and the doors will remain open until 8:55am. Please can we ask all parents to help us with this by not congregating in the yard.

We are currently reviewing Parents' Evening for R-Y5 and should cancellation of this event be required we will let you know as soon as possible. As of today, Year 6 Parents' Evening will go ahead as planned on Tuesday, however, the format of the meeting may be slightly different and the meetings will take place in the front area of school. Should Parents' Evening be postponed, it will be rearranged later in the year. As always, Teachers will prepare a detailed annual report for your child.

SHOULD THE GOVERNMENT DECIDE TO CLOSE SCHOOLS

Britannia Community Primary School will follow the Department for Education guidance with regard to any decisions to close the school. At the time of writing, the school has **NO** plans to close but will keep up-to-date with Government announcements and local issues.

If a decision is made to close the school for an extended period, Britannia School still has an obligation to provide an education to children during the school closure period. If this happens, teaching staff will provide logins and links to enable children to access education digitally. The class page of the School Website will show a timetable of activities to be completed. Some classes may send home an exercise book for work to be completed in, or paper copies of work.
